Cancellation re-routing codes

Should an **Inter-Island** trip be cancelled for any reason, customers are often re-routed through Hyannis. The customer should *not* have to pay any additional money for this extra trip through Hyannis.

Use the following codes to re-book standard fare travel:

P # ICA adult or P # ICA O

P # ICC child or P # ICC O

To re-route **RESIDENT RATES** (IRA/IRC codes) through Hyannis, use the following codes:

P # IHA adult or P # IHA O

P # IHC child or P # IHC O

These codes should be used in lieu of manually pricing or comp category. The rates for two trips should be the same as the price they originally paid for 1 direct inter-island route.

By utilizing this code, it helps identify passengers who will be making a connection in Hyannis. If you are booking a passenger for ANY of these trips and their connecting time in Hyannis is less than 20 minutes, you must notify the boat that they have passengers onboard who should be allowed to disembark first; also advise if passengers have luggage to ensure their items make the tight connection as well.
